CNCERT organized the 4th China-ASEAN Network Security Seminar in Dalian, China on Aug 8, 2011, with sponsorship from International Cooperation Department of China's Ministry of Industry and Information Technology (MIIT). Delegates from the telecom department of government and CERTs in Cambodia, Lao, Thailand, Viet Nam and Malaysia as well as the ASEAN Secretariat attended this conference.
